Collaboration Challenges

- Need for common understanding. Each discipline has unique perspectives & vocabulary
- Need in the virtual environment to work together, schedule their work, and stay on track.
- Need to generate ideas, articulate problems
- Need a central repository of information and files.
- Be able to assess, analyze, and plan for the needs of the industry partner.

Collaboration Challenges cont'd

- Need to communicate and disseminate information to a varied audience
- Need a platform that is intuitive & easy to use
- Need software that is readily available, open source and customizable, or free.

- Collaborative writing.
- Virtual meetings – class/team forums, chat, calendar.
- Virtual Course Pack (textbook)
- Information Resources – portals such as AgNIC, data sets, library databases.
- Virtual conferencing

- What is Sakai?
 - Open-source, customizable, web-based learning and collaboration environment.
 - Organized into user-generated ‘Sites’ – collections of information and communications intended for a specific set of users.
 - An Iron Chef (**Hiroyuki Sakai**)

- Extensive (and growing) toolset and customizable interface
- Excellent user and access management

- Syndicated news feeds (rss).
- Maintains an integrated learning or project environment, when Sakai's features don't meet all your needs.

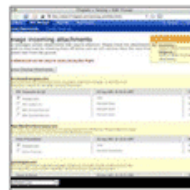

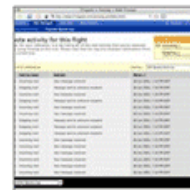

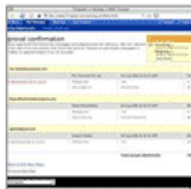
