MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

OUR 24th Annual Report has been prepared to give a brief but complete report of progress made during the past year to those whose support makes possible the work of the Cornell Research Laboratory for Diseases of Dogs.

The Research Program: In the past year, research activities by the staff of the Cornell Research Laboratory for Diseases of Dogs have focused on 29 projects. This work has produced 13 publications. Essentially, the projects cover viral, bacterial, physiological, clinical, nutritional, and biochemical studies. Titles of projects are listed alphabetically by name of the research leader.







In the past year, more veterinarians have become Research Partners. This continued response has been of great value in helping the research program of the Laboratory. More and more dog clubs are giving greater support, making possible an expanded and diversified research program.

Dr. Hadley C. Stephenson, Professor of Veterinary Therapeutics and Small Animal Diseases, Emeritus, at Cornell, has been a member of the staff of the Cornell Research Laboratory for Diseases of Dogs since his retirement in 1953 from fulltime teaching and research responsibilities. A research laboratory for the study of canine diseases was dedicated in honor of Dr. Stephenson. For 21 years, Dr. Stephenson has been instrumental in developing and maintaining a cooperative relationship between the Cornell Research Laboratory for Diseases of Dogs and its supporters. He has helped to promote better health for dogs through the dissemination of information developed by research of the Laboratory.

Financial Situation: In 1972-73 we failed to balance the budget, having a deficit of \$75,384. This year the financial situation improved substantially, and the deficit was reduced to \$16,825. Receipts from 1971-72 New York State dog license fees were made available to be utilized in 1973-74. This was an important factor in reducing the deficit. These funds also enabled the Laboratory to acquire several essential items of laboratory equipment.




A. WELLS PECK

A. Wells Peck died at the age of 85 on September 15, 1974, as the result of an automobile accident near his home in Litchfield, Connecticut. We shall remember him for nearly a quarter of a century of loyal effort in support of the Cornell Research Laboratory for Diseases of Dogs. Mr. Peck was one of the founders of the Cornell Research Laboratory for Diseases of Dogs in 1950, and he contributed substantially to its success in all of the years that followed.

Mr. Peck was noted as a breeder of Norwegian Elkhounds and he produced some of the finest dogs of the breed. He believed that the relationship between a dog and its owner was very important and that a breeder should show his own dogs. He has been seen nationally in many show rings. The contributions of Mr. and Mrs. Peck to the breed in this country were recognized last year with a special show in their honor in Los Angeles. Also, they were the only Americans to achieve honorary membership in the National Elkhound Club of Norway.

It is with the deepest regret that we have learned of his death and we shall miss his visits, his counsel, and his sincere interest in the health of dogs.

BEQUESTS

DR. VAUGHN W. ROOD

Dr. Vaughn W. Rood, a veterinarian of Springville, New York, for 67 years, died on May 27, 1974. Dr. Rood was born in the Ithaca area in 1884 and attended schools there. He graduated with high honors from the New York State Veterinary College at Cornell University in 1907. He established residence in Springville that year and practiced veterinary surgery there until his retirement in 1974.

Dr. Rood believed in research to promote better health for animals and demonstrated his confidence in the Cornell Research Laboratory for Diseases of Dogs by making it a beneficiary in his will.

MARJORIE LANGLEY RYAN

Mrs. Marjorie Langley Ryan, a lawyer in New York City, died at her home on Central Park South in March 1973. She was a member of the New York State Bar Association and the Association of the Bar of the City of New York.

Mrs. Ryan was the first and perhaps the only woman licensed as a harbor pilot in New York Harbor. She received her license in the late nineteen-twenties. She also had studied navigation, and had taught Braille at Hunter College.

Mrs. Ryan had great regard for the late Dr. J. Stuart Crawford of New Hyde Park, L. I., who was veterinarian for her dogs for several decades. In his honor, Mrs. Ryan bequeathed a part of her estate to the Cornell Research Laboratory for Diseases of Dogs.
