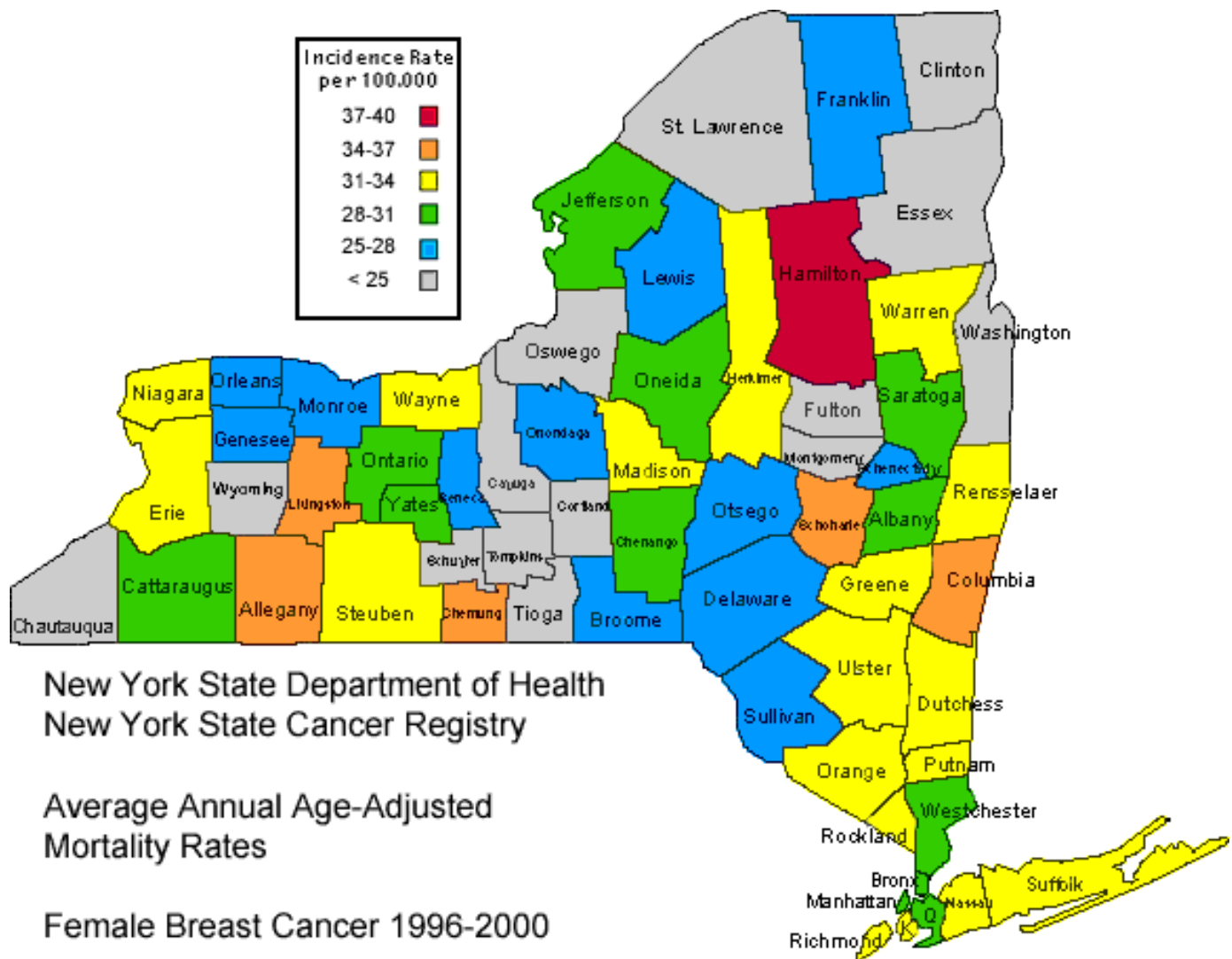


Mortality from Breast Cancer 1996 – 2000 in New York State
